

Mass Intentions Guidelines

- The Mass Intention Calendar is kept by the Parish Cluster Secretary. Arrangements for a particular day can be made by calling or stopping by the Parish Office.
- The Archdiocesan prescribed donation for a Mass Offering is \$7.00. Those who cannot afford to make such an offering may still designate a day for the intention of their loved one.
- Because there are fewer Masses available from the clustering of the parishes, effective immediately and to permit greater access to the parish's liturgical calendar by all parishioners, requests for Masses are limited to one Mass per month per household, with a maximum of 12 Masses per year, which includes a maximum of two Masses being weekend Masses.
- Canon Law prohibits accepting stipends for Masses more than one year in advance.
- Masses are assigned on a first come, first served basis.
- The parish reserves the right to change a date *if necessary*. In that case, the person making the request will be notified of the change, if we are given their contact information.
- As per Church Law, one of the Masses each weekend is designated as Pro populo (for the Parishioners of the Parish Cluster), as well as one of the Masses for a holy day.
- If you wish to request more Masses than outlined above, we would be happy to send the extra Mass Intentions to the Missions for you.
