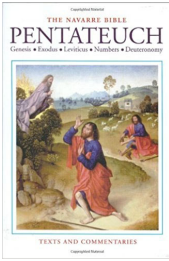

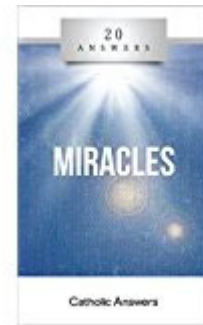


**Navarre Bible Study: Deuteronomy**—Deuteronomy is the title commonly given by the Christian Church to the fifth book of the Pentateuch. The name comes from the Septuagint Greek translation of Deuteronomy 17:18; instead of translating “he shall write for himself in a book *a copy of this law*,” the translators put *this second law* (= *to deuteronomion touto*). However, the title is not inappropriate, because the book includes, along with historical accounts, long discourses, exhortations etc., a second body of laws similar in content (with more or less substantial differences, depending on the case) found in the book of Exodus (and, sometimes, in Leviticus). In Judaism this book is known by its opening words: *‘Elleh ha-debarim* (“These are the words”) or, simply, *Debarim* (“Words”).
